On September 10, 2007, Christopher Guttman-McCabe, Vice President, Regulatory Affairs, CTIA – The Wireless Association®, responded to separate inquiries from Angela Giancarlo, Legal Advisor to Commissioner Robert M. McDowell, and Renee Crittendon, Legal Advisor to Commissioner Jonathan Adelstein, concerning the September 7, 2007 *ex parte* communication filed by the Association of Public-Safety Officials-International and National Emergency Number Association. During the telephone conversation, Mr. Guttman-McCabe voiced concerns regarding the setting of any interim benchmarks or compliance dates for any new E911 requirements at this time. Mr. Guttman-McCabe noted that nothing in the record supports these benchmarks or deadlines. Moreover, this proposal and the difficult questions it raises would be more appropriately addressed in the ongoing “Part III.B” of the above-captioned proceeding.
