Dear Ms. Dortch:

Pursuant to the Commission's orders in this proceeding, Time Warner Cable Inc. ("TWC") was required to certify compliance with the cable/SMATV cross-ownership restriction with respect to certain properties acquired in the above-referenced transactions.¹ As of August 1, 2007, TWC had provided the requisite certifications for all but one Los Angeles area SMATV property subject to the rule.² The Media Bureau granted TWC until October 1, 2007 to complete interconnection and provide its certification of compliance relating to this final property.³



As detailed in previous filings with the Commission, TWC has experienced significant delays in reaching a final agreement for interconnection of this final property due to a number of complications.⁴ This property, where TWC serves approximately 241 subscribers, consists of both condominiums and rental units. TWC has actively pursued negotiations with both the condo board and rental property management in an effort to reach the agreements necessary to permit interconnection.

After numerous meetings and phone conversations, TWC remains hopeful that execution of these documents is imminent. As explained in a telephone conversation between Susan Mort of Time Warner Inc. and Royce Sherlock of the Media Bureau on September 7, 2007, however, even if TWC receives executed documents within the next few weeks, it would need additional time (most likely several weeks) to provide any required subscriber notices and complete the integration of this property.⁵ Thus, in light of the concerns raised by the potential need for TWC to terminate service to affected subscribers at this property, TWC hereby respectfully requests an additional sixty (60) days, or until November 30, 2007, to continue to pursue negotiations with both the condo board and rental property management to enable TWC to fulfill its obligations under the Commission's orders in this proceeding by means other than termination of service to customers at this final property.
