This is to inform you that, on September 12, 2007, Stephen Collins, Senior Director, Government and Regulatory Affairs - Global, and Christopher Libertelli, Senior Director, Government and Regulatory Affairs - North America, of Skype Communications, S.A.R.L. ("Skype"), and the undersigned met with Marcus Maher and Nicholas Alexander of the Wireline Competition Bureau. The purpose of the meeting was to discuss Skype's evolution as a multi-faceted Internet communications tool – including a bundle of services ranging from social networking, voice and video calling, web presence, instant messaging, and money transfer – that is not designed, marketed, or used as a replacement telephone service. We also discussed the ways in which Skype users utilize the software, confirming our view that Skype users do not view it as a replacement telephone service.
