On September 12, 2007, Larry Page, Co-Founder and President of Products at Google, engaged in a telephone conversation with FCC Chairman Kevin J. Martin. In that conversation, Mr. Page stated that timely and successful culmination of the pending TV “white spaces” proceeding is of considerable importance to consumers and the high-tech industry. He explained in particular that digital televisions and wireless microphones can be amply protected from any harmful interference by unlicensed personal/portable devices, using reasonable power levels and sensing thresholds.
