Dear Ms. Dortch:

On 13 September 2007, Kerry Murray and Neeraj Srivastava of Dell, Inc. and Scott Blake Harris representing Dell, met with Commissioner Copps and Bruce Gottlieb, the Commissioner's legal advisor, regarding the TV white spaces proceeding.

During this meeting, Dell stressed the importance of authorizing personal/portable devices, which will ensure the highest and best use of the white spaces while protecting incumbent operations in the TV bands. Specifically, Dell observed that

- Dell plans to make a substantial commitment to white space operations.
- Personal/portable devices should be authorized at the same time as fixed devices, if not before.
- The record will demonstrate that white space devices will protect incumbent operations.
- If additional testing would help the Commission, Dell would support such testing even if the final decision in this proceeding slips slightly beyond the Commission's projected October deadline.
- Dell stands ready to provide the Commission with any assistance it might require should it undertake additional testing.
