Dear Ms. Dortch:

On 13 September 2007, Craig Mundie of Microsoft Corp. had a telephone conversation with Commissioner Copps and Bruce Gottlieb, the Commissioner's legal advisor, regarding the TV white spaces proceeding. During the call, the parties discussed the possibility of additional testing by the Commission, as well as testing recently undertaken by Microsoft to further demonstrate the ability of personal/portable white space devices to protect incumbent television operations.

Mr. Mundie noted Microsoft's willingness to work with the Commission to resolve any open questions, even if in doing so it was necessary for the Commission to take a few additional weeks beyond October to complete its research and adopt final rules. However, Mr. Mundie stressed the importance of authorizing personal/portable devices at the same time that the Commission authorizes fixed devices to ensure innovative, widespread use of the white spaces.
