Dear Sirs:

I am writing in reference to CC Docket No. 02-6 to appeal the SLD Funding Commitment Decision Letter from December 27, 2006. Our BEN is 143384 and the corresponding 471 number is 534865. I have made an appeal to the SLD, but due to staff turnover at our vendor, I was unable to supply the documentation they requested in a timely fashion and was denied. I am requesting reconsideration because the delay in supplying information was outside of my control.

The FRNs 1486046 & 1486084 were denied by the SLD with the reason that 30% or more of each service was ineligible.

FRN 1486046 for Local and Long Distance Telephone Service had a Directory Listing charge in addition to basic service. The amount for that ineligible service, annually, is \$819.36 (\$68.28 monthly, including taxes and fees for the service). The eligible amount for this FRN is \$1,263.72. We are requesting that the eligible amount be changed to this amount and the funding be approved.

FRN 1486084 for Basic Maintenance of Internal Connections had one server listed as the Library Catalog Server. This server machine mostly performs the DNS functions of our network as well as the Catalog Server function. DNS service is 90% of the function of this server, while the Catalog Server functions take up 10% of the usage of the server. Attached is a letter from our vendor explaining the determination of usage.

Our provider for Basic Maintenance of Internal Connections service charges us \$240 per month per server for maintenance. So the ineligible portion (10% of billed amount) would be \$24 per month or \$240 annually. I am requesting that you reduce our eligible amount by \$240 for the FRN and approve funding. The attached letter also explains the monthly fees charged by our vendor for these

maintenance services.

Dear Sirs:

I am writing in response to your request for a document explaining both the monthly fees and the allocation of usage of the database/DNS server.

I will address the monthly fee first. The charge for server maintenance is \$200 per month, per server. This amounts to \$400 per month. This amount was reported to the SLD by email in response to a request on May 29, 2007.

The remainder of the charge (being \$133.75 per month) is to maintain the cabling and terminations, switches, hubs and router. This is our standard retainer rate for these services

for a client of Moise Memorial Library's size.



As for the allocation of usage of the database/DNS server, we made our determination based on the number of requests for each of the services. The database is used when a book is checked out or a patron uses the electronic card catalog. The DNS server is used whenever someone queries a domain name from the Internet. The number of DNS queries is far more than 10 times the number of database queries. Because database queries involve slightly larger amounts of data, we made the estimation at 10% usage for those queries.

Though determining an exact figure would be very difficult and time consuming, we believe that this is a very fair estimate.
