Dear Ms. Dortch:

On September 14, 2007, Kerry Murray and Neeraj Srivastava of Dell, Inc., and Paul Margie representing Dell, met with Commissioner Jonathan S. Adelstein and his Legal Advisor Rudy Brioché, regarding the TV white spaces proceeding.

During this meeting, Dell stressed the importance of authorizing personal/portable devices, which will ensure the highest and best use of the white spaces while protecting incumbent operations in the TV bands. Dell stated that it was willing to work with the Commission on additional testing to resolve any open questions, even if such testing would require a short delay in the Commission's consideration of the matter and that it is ready to provide the Commission with assistance it requests related to additional testing. Dell also discussed the differences in detecting wireless microphone and DTV signals, and how a white space device could detect a device that was activated after the white space device scanned for signals.
