Re: Qwest Petition for Forbearance Under 47 U.S.C. § 160© from Title II and *Computer Inquiry* Rules with Respect to Broadband Services, WC Dkt. No. 06-125

Dear Ms. Dortch:

T-Mobile USA, Inc. (“T-Mobile”) hereby files the attached comments in response to Qwest Corporation and Qwest Communications Corporation’s (jointly, “Qwest”) petition for forbearance pursuant to section 10(c) of the Communications Act of 1934, filed September 12, 2007. Qwest’s petition requests that the Commission forbear from applying Title II and the *Computer Inquiry* rules “to any broadband services Qwest does or may offer to the extent those services are not offered as part of an Internet access service.”<sup>1</sup>

Qwest’s recently filed petition is virtually identical to the forbearance petition it had filed June 13, 2006,<sup>2</sup> which was withdrawn on September 11, 2007. At Qwest’s request for expedited treatment, the Commission established a very short pleading cycle for the new petition.<sup>3</sup> In light of the tight comment period and the fact that Qwest’s recent petition raises no new issues, T-Mobile hereby submits its previously-filed reply comments opposing Qwest’s 2006 petition. In addition, T-Mobile requests that the Commission incorporate all other filings and *ex parte* letters submitted by T-Mobile and others in response to Qwest’s earlier petition as part of the record used to evaluate Qwest’s current petition.
