

My name is Tyrone Bynum, CEO for Ghettothropic LLC - Owner and distributor of the 30 minute television program Community's Choice. I am petitioning your office for a closed captioning exemption -- According (11) **Captioning expense in excess of 2% of gross revenues**. No video programming provider shall be required to expend any money to caption any video programming if such expenditure would exceed 2% of the gross revenues received from that channel during the previous calendar year. Ghettothropic LLC gross billings last year were \$0.00. Our projected gross billings this year is less than \$20,000.00. Therefore I am also requesting the Undue Burden Exemption.

Community's Choice is scheduled to begin airing on WDYM, WHTV, and WXSP the weekend of September 8 and 9, 2007. Community's Choice is a weekly half hour television program dealing with issues and concerns defined by the viewing community.


