
Dear Ms. Dortch:

This letter is to report a permitted, oral *ex parte* communication of Frontline Wireless, LLC (“Frontline”) and its counsel concerning the above-referenced proceedings.

On October 1, 2007, Janice Obuchowski and Jonathan Blake met with Aaron Goldberger, legal advisor to Chairman Kevin J. Martin. The parties discussed the undesirable consequences of the high reserve prices placed on the C and D Blocks and the fact that the C Block conditions would vanish, and the D Block conditions could vanish, if the reserve is not met. Further, the parties spoke about efforts by potential licensees to dilute the open platform requirements attached to the C Block. In addition, the parties talked about important timing considerations, such as the need to establish a deadline for filing a short form application that provides parties ample opportunity to prepare, and the interaction between the Bureau’s auction rule proceeding and the petitions for reconsideration currently before the Commission in the service rules proceeding. Finally, the parties discussed the DE credit and the impact of the *Council Tree* decision on the DE eligibility rules for the 700 MHz auction.
