
Dear Ms. Dortch:

On September 28, 2007, Frontline Wireless, LLC (“Frontline”) filed yet another entry in a seemingly endless string of unauthorized pleadings. In its latest missive, counsel for Frontline demands that the FCC refuse “to consider any substantive arguments Verizon Wireless (‘Verizon’) has made or will make in opposition to the Commission’s *700 MHz Second Report & Order* until Verizon files a written petition for reconsideration . . . .” See Motion of Frontline Wireless, LLC at 1, WT Docket Nos. 06-150, 06-169, 03-264, 01-309, 96-86; PS Docket No. 06-229; CC Docket No. 94-102 (filed Sept. 28, 2007) (the “Motion”).

As the Motion acknowledges, the facts are clear that (1) Verizon Wireless had a meeting concerning the *700 MHz Second Report & Order* on September 17, 2007 prior to the deadline for filing petitions for reconsideration;<sup>1</sup> (2) Verizon Wireless elected not to seek reconsideration of the *700 MHz Second Report & Order*; and (3) the statutory deadline for petitioning the FCC for reconsideration has expired.<sup>2</sup> Against this factual backdrop, Frontline’s latest motion borders on the absurd and should be summarily discarded.
