Petition for Reconsideration

Fort Myers Broadcasting Company (“FMBC”), licensee of television broadcast station WINK-DT, Fort Myers, Florida, seeks reconsideration of Seventh Report and Order and Eighth Further Notice of Proposed Rule Making, FCC 07-138 (the “Seventh Report and Order”), released August 6, 2007, for the limited purpose of correcting the operating parameters of WINK-DT, Facility ID No. 22093, as set out in Appendix B of the “Seventh Report and Order”.

FMBC notes that the antenna height above average terrain listed in Appendix B is six meters above the licensed antenna height above average terrain of WINK-DT. See BLCDT-20060531ADP. FAA considerations and the need to top mount WINK-FM on the antenna structure prevent WINK-DT from increasing its antenna height above average terrain. So WINK-DT will not be able to operate post-transition with the antenna height above average terrain currently specified in Appendix B. Accordingly FMBC requests the Commission to amend Appendix B to specify an antenna height above average terrain of 445 meters for Facility ID No. 22093, DTV Channel 9, Fort Myers, Florida. Because this is a reduction of the WINK-DT facilities specified in Appendix B, no other television station can be adversely affected by

grant of the requested change to Appendix B.
