Dear Ms. Dortch:

This letter discloses a permitted *ex parte* contact in the above-referenced matter. On Thursday, October 4, 2007, undersigned counsel, on behalf of Centennial Communications Corp., accompanied by Mr. William L. Roughton, Jr., Centennial's Vice President of Legal & Regulatory Affairs, met with Ms. Jennifer O'Keefe and other staff members of the Telecommunications Access Policy Division. The purpose of the meeting was to discuss Centennial's and other parties' comments and reply comments in the above-noted matter.

Specifically, in addition to reviewing points contained in our comments and reply comments, we discussed the fact that Centennial's investment in new, network-expanding facilities in Puerto Rico exceeded the amount of its ICLS funding during the relevant past periods (the first and second halves of 2004). In addition we discussed the differences between Centennial's receipt of ICLS funding, used to expand its network used to provide supported services, with PRTC's receipt of ICLS funding during a period when its number of lines in service was declining.
