

Dear Ms. Dortch:

Enclosed is the Oklahoma Telephone Association's (OTA) application to the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) for renewal of its five-year certification of the State of Oklahoma's Intrastate Telecommunications Relay Services (TRS) Program.

The enclosed application establishes that, consistent with the FCC's Public Notice (DA 07-2761) released on June 27, 2007, Oklahoma's TRS state program (1) "meets or exceeds all operational, technical, and functional minimum standards contained in 47 C.F.R. §64.604; (2) "makes available adequate procedures and remedies for enforcing the requirements of the state program"; and, (3) where Oklahoma's program exceeds the mandatory minimum standards contained in §64.604, it in no way conflicts with federal law. The OTA certifies that it has and will continue to comply with the American's with Disabilities Act (ADA) standard relay guidelines and will oversee its current TRS provider to ensure that all requirements are met.
