
Dear Ms. Dortch:

This letter is to report a permitted, oral *ex parte* communication of Frontline Wireless, LLC's ("Frontline's") counsel concerning the above-referenced proceedings.

On October 12, 2007, Jonathan Blake spoke via telephone with Bruce Gottlieb, legal advisor to Commissioner Michael J. Copps. The parties discussed the DE eligibility rules and the issue of whether an otherwise eligible small business with a wholesale business model, who builds out and operates a network, would qualify for the bidding credit. Further, the parties spoke about the *Council Tree* decision recently handed down by the United States Court of Appeals for the Third Circuit, and the implications of this decision for the Commission's application of its DE eligibility rules to the C and D block licenses.
