NOTICE OF WITHDRAWAL OF PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION

Cellular Phone of Kentucky, Inc., Litchfield County Cellular, Inc. dba Ramcell of Kentucky, and Litchfield County Cellular, Inc. d/b/a Ramcell of Oregon (collectively “Petitioners”), by their attorneys, hereby notify the Commission of the withdrawal their Petition for Reconsideration in the above referenced docket.¹

Petitioners sought reconsideration of aspects of the Commission’s May 2, 2007 Order in the above-referenced docket.² By Consent Decree released August 7, 2007, Petitioners and the Commission have reached a settlement of all matters in the *Order*.³ Petitioners have complied with the operative requirements of the *Consent Decree* and its
