Dear Commissioners:

On behalf of Caribou County, I am filing this letter to certify the number of narrowband mobile and portable handsets and base stations serving these handsets that were in operation as of August 30, 2007 to be eligible for relocation costs to the new consolidated segments.

As indicated in the Second Report and Order, the following information is provided.

1. The total number of narrowband mobile and portable handsets in operation in channel 63 and 68 (764-767/794-797 MHz), and the upper 1 MHz of channels 64 and 69 (775-776/805-806 MHz) is 23 mobiles, 50 portables and 1 control stations for a total 74 units.
2. The area of operation of the mobiles and portable units is within the boundary of Caribou County, Idaho.
3. The total number of narrowband base stations serving these handsets in operation is 0.
