
Dear Ms. Dortch:

This letter is to report permitted, oral *ex parte* communications of Frontline Wireless, LLC's ("Frontline's") counsel concerning the above-referenced proceedings.

On October 18, 2007, Jonathan Blake spoke via telephone with Renee Crittendon, legal advisor to Jonathan Adelstein. In addition, Mr. Blake spoke several times to Aaron Goldberger, legal advisor to Chairman Kevin Martin. In these conversations, the parties discussed the *Council Tree* decision recently handed down by the United States Court of Appeals for the Third Circuit, the implications of this decision for the Commission's DE eligibility rules, and how the DE rules should be structured, including the limitations on the sale to any one purchaser and how these limitations would be implemented and measured. The parties also spoke about the default provision which would apply to the D Block auction winner in the event of failed negotiations with the Public Safety Broadband Licensee, regardless of whether or not the D Block winner negotiated in good faith.
