Pursuant to PS Docket No.06-229, WT Docket No.96-86, and DA 07-4168 the State of Mississippi submits the following:

1. The total number of narrowband mobiles and portables handsets in operation in channels 63 and 68 (764-767/794/797 MHz) and the upper a MHz of channels of channels 64 and 69 (775-776/805-806 MHz) is **1450 units**.
2. The areas of operation of the mobile and portable units are **Mississippi Highway Safety Districts 7, 8 and 9**.
3. The total number of narrowband base stations serving these 1450 units is **31 base stations**.
