
Dear Ms. Dortch:

This letter is to report permitted, oral *ex parte* communications of Frontline Wireless, LLC (“Frontline”) and its counsel concerning the above-referenced proceedings.

On October 19, 2007, Gerard Waldron spoke to Bruce Gottlieb, legal advisor to Commissioner Michael Copps, and Jonathan Blake spoke via telephone with Renee Crittendon, legal advisor to Commissioner Jonathan Adelstein. In addition, on both the 19th and the 20th, Mr. Blake spoke to Aaron Goldberger, legal advisor to Chairman Kevin Martin. On October 19, 2007, James Barksdale spoke to Chairman Kevin Martin. In these conversations, the parties discussed the *Council Tree* decision recently handed down by the United States Court of Appeals for the Third Circuit, the implications of this decision for the Commission’s DE eligibility rules, and how the DE rules should be structured, including the limitations on the sale of network services to any one customer and restrictions on financing by such customers.
