

Pursuant to PS Docket No. 06-229, WT Docket No.96-86, and DA 07-4168 the State of Arkansas (AWIN) submits the following.

1. The total number of narrowband mobiles and portable handsets in operation in channels 63 and 68 (764-767/794-797 MHz) channels 64 and 69 (775-776/805-806 MHz) is 9419.
2. The areas of operation of the mobile and portable units are statewide.
3. The total number of narrowband base stations serving these 9419 thousand units is 8.
