On October 22, 2007, Michael O'Connor and the undersigned, both of NeuStar, Inc. (NeuStar), met with Scott Bergmann, legal advisor to Commissioner Adelstein to discuss the above-referenced proceeding. The purpose of the meeting was to discuss the points previously raised in NeuStar's opposition to Telcordia's petition. In particular, we discussed NeuStar's number portability administration contracts that benefit carriers and consumers and that serve the public interest. We also reiterated our view that Telcordia has offered no legal or policy rationale to overturn commercial contracts that Telcordia failed to win in the marketplace.
