On October 22, 2007, Sunil Daluvoy, senior manager for new business development for Google Inc. ("Google"), and the undersigned, met with four representatives from the Commission's Public Safety and Homeland Security Bureau: Derek Poarch, Bureau Chief; Erika Olsen, Deputy Chief; Timothy Peterson, Chief of Staff; and Carol Simpson, Legal Counsel. Discussions included various questions concerning the rights and responsibilities of the eventual "D" Block licensee. In particular, the Google representatives sought clarification of the FCC's compliance timelines, the selection process for the Public Safety Broadband Licensee ("PSBL"), mandatory and permissive elements of the Network Sharing Agreement ("NSA"), procedures for NSA-related negotiations with the PSBL, and the D Block licensee's ability to provide wholesale, retail, or other types of access to its wireless network.
