Supplement to Sanctions Motion Against AT&T and Its Counsel

When a carrier and its inside and outside counsel engage in intentional misrepresentation to the Courts and the FCC not only does the petitioner suffer.

The case at hand is a matter in which the FCC's limited resources are being abused due to AT&T's unlawful misconduct in the marketplace.

AT&T is being rewarded for its misconduct because the more cases that it asserts to the Courts that must go through the FCC the more AT&T ties up the FCC resources.
