This letter is to report permitted, oral *ex parte* communications of Frontline Wireless, LLC's ("Frontline's") counsel concerning the above-referenced proceedings.

On October 25, 2007, Jonathan Blake spoke to Aaron Goldberger, legal advisor to Chairman Kevin Martin, and Fred Campbell, Chief of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau. On the same day, Gerard Waldron spoke to Bruce Gottlieb, legal advisor to Commissioner Michael Copps. The parties discussed the Commission's DE eligibility rules and their application to a wholesaling small business. In particular, they spoke about how the DE rules should be structured, including the limitations on the sale of network services to any one customer and whether there should be any restrictions on financing by such customers.
