Adelstein and his Legal Advisors, Scott Bergmann and Renee Crittendon. At that meeting the following matters were discussed:

The evidence in the record of a persistent market failure in the U.S. wholesale special access services market, that Ethernet pricing is yet another example of a specific failure in special access as BT has highlighted in its ex parte filed in this docket on October 11, 2007, and that the Commission must act to cut special access rates and regulate wholesale enterprise access to promote service competition which will drive market-driven access infrastructure innovation.
