On October 29, 2007, Robert Quinn, Joan Marsh and Gary Phillips, representing AT&T, met with Renee Crittendon, Legal Advisor to Commissioner Jonathan Adelstein. At the meeting, AT&T discussed the public interest benefits of the proposed license transfers as described in the application filed in the above-referenced proceeding and as further discussed in Applicants' joint opposition. We stressed the importance of expedited action to ensure that the benefits of the transaction can accrue promptly to Dobson subscribers in its largely rural territory. We also requested prompt action on the application so AT&T can position itself to fully meet the demands of the Holiday retail season.
