
Dear Ms. Dortch:

This letter is to report a permitted, oral *ex parte* communication of Frontline Wireless, LLC's ("Frontline's") counsel concerning the above-referenced proceedings.

On October 29, 2007, Gerard Waldron communicated by phone with Aaron Goldberger, legal advisor to Chairman Kevin Martin. Mr. Waldron explained the need for prompt Commission action to revise its rules governing DE eligibility to allow wholesaling small businesses to receive the DE credit, with appropriate limitations on the sale of network services to any one customer.
