
Dear Ms. Dortch:

This letter is to report a permitted, oral *ex parte* communication of Frontline Wireless, LLC (“Frontline”) concerning the above-referenced proceedings.

On October 30, 2007, Reed Hundt, Vice Chairman of Frontline, spoke with Commissioner Jonathan Adelstein. The parties discussed the need for prompt Commission action to revise its rules governing DE eligibility to allow wholesaling small businesses to receive the DE credit. An immediate resolution of this issue is necessary to allow small businesses to raise the capital required to bid in the 700 MHz auction.
