PETITION FOR RULE MAKING

J. L. Brewer Broadcasting of Cleveland, LLC ("Brewer") hereby requests the allotment of Channel 265A to Lula, Georgia as that community's first local service.<sup>1</sup> If this Petition is granted, Brewer will file an application for Channel 265A at Lula, and will construct the facilities if its application is granted. The following table summarizes the changes requested in this Petition:

As demonstrated in the Technical Exhibit, Channel 265A can be allotted to Lula consistent with Section 73.207 the Commission's Rules with respect to all existing and proposed

domestic allotments and facilities.<sup>2</sup> A 70 dBu signal can be provided to Lula from the proposed reference coordinates.

Lula evidences the attributes that the Commission traditionally associates with a community. Lula is identified in the 2000 U.S. Census with a population of 1,438 and therefore is presumed to have the status of a community for allotment purposes. *See Arnold and Columbia, California*, 7 FCC Rcd 6302 (1992). Lula, Georgia, is an historic railroad town that was formally incorporated in 1876. The community's strong connection with the railroads and associated industries continues to the present: this year marked the community's thirty-first annual Railroad Days festival. Railroad Days, which draws attendees from neighboring communities, features parades, shopping, and entertainment and has been described by one Lula resident as "the best part of the year." *See Exhibit 1*.

The City of Lula is governed by a city council, whose five members represent the community's five electoral districts. The United States postal service has assigned one zip code (30554) to Lula and maintains a post office in the community. The residents of Lula are served by the Hall County Fire Department, which maintains a stationhouse in Lula. The community is also home to the Lula Elementary School. Finally, Lula is home to a number of business and community organizations, including Lula Mini-Storage and Car Wash, Lula Pharmacy and Gift Shop, Bennie's Pizza, Inc., David's Corner Café, Lula Church, Lula Assembly of Praise, and Lula Full Gospel Worship Center. *See Exhibit 1*.



<sup>2</sup> The channel study notes a short-spacing to Channel 266C0 at Anderson, South Carolina (used by WROQ(FM)). However, WROQ changed its channel from Channel 266C0 to Channel 266C1 in MB Docket No. 05-282. The effective date of the Commission's decision in that proceeding was October 17, 2007. The channel study also notes a short-spacing to an application filed by WNCC-FM on Channel 265A. However, this application was prematurely filed and is technically deficient. Thus, Brewer is contemporaneously filing an Informal Objection to the WNCC-FM application.

For the foregoing reasons, Brewer respectfully requests that the Commission allot 265A to Lula, Georgia as that community's first local service.

## **PETITION FOR RULE MAKING REQUESTING THE ALLOCATION OF CHANNEL 265A TO LULA, GA**

This Technical Report is provided in support of a petition for rule making proposing the assignment of channel 265A at Lula, GA and its associated FCC Form 301.

### **I. Summary of Proposed Allocations Changes**

### **II. Allocations considerations:**

The proposed channel 265A assignment will provide a first local service at Lula, GA (1,438) and an FCC terrain based 60 dBu contour with a population of 201,506 and an area of 2,537 sq km at (NAD 27) N 34-28-25 W 83-46-00 (ASR#1228895).

A channel study is included as Exhibit E-1 demonstrating that the allocation is fully spaced at the proposed site as a result of the declass of WROQ to 266C1 as ordered in MB Docket No. 05-282. Exhibit E2 demonstrates that the proposed facility provides a 70 dBu to the entire community of Lula.

### **III. Antenna System and RF Considerations:**


A three bay full wavelength spaced ERI antenna mounted at a COR AGL of 73 meters will exhibit a maximum RF contribution of 8.3 microwatts/cm<sup>2</sup> (4.1% of the general public exposure limit) as calculated using the Commission's FMMODEL program. This level is less than the 5% of the limit requiring evaluation.



**FCC TERRAIN BASED 70 DBU**


**LULA BOUNDARIES**







## Lula Railroad Days a big hit

LULA - Lula Mayor Milton Turner is always a little tense before the start of the annual Lula Railroad Days festival. But this year he had even more reason to be nervous as the small Hall County town got ready for the day-long celebration.

"We took a more active role this year," Turner said with a nervous smile just minutes before the parade kicked off the day's events.

The unprecedented role by the town is the first time in the event's history - the first Lula Railroad Day was in 1976 - is has decided to get actively involved in the planning.

"Usually the Lula Area Betterman's Association has handled the festival but this year it was a joint venture by the town and we're anxious to see how it goes," Tuner said.

More than 50 booths and of course the nearly mile-long parade were part of the day's activities, which saw thousands of people line Main Street through town.

The parade had a special Grand Marshall in the Class AAA state champion East Hall girls basketball team.

Thousands of people lined Main Street for the parade, which lasted about 40 minutes, and were treated to classic cars, fire trucks, funny cars, floats, and the East Hall High Marching Band.

## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

To amend an Act providing a new charter for the City of Lula, approved April 5, 1994 (Ga. L. 1994, p. 4841), so as to provide for city council election districts; to provide for definitions and inclusions; to provide for continuation in office of current councilmembers; to provide for other related matters; to provide for submission of this Act for approval under the federal Voting Rights Act of 1965, as amended; to provide for effective dates; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

### **SECTION 1.**

An Act providing a new charter for the City of Lula, approved April 5, 1994 (Ga. L. 1994, p. 4841), is amended by striking subsections (d) and (e) of Section 2.10 and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

"(d)(1) For purposes of electing members of the city council, the City of Lula is divided into five residency districts. One member of the council shall be elected from each such district. No person shall be eligible to serve as a councilmember for a district unless such person has been a resident of the district for the 12 months immediately preceding the election of councilmembers. Each such person shall continue to reside within the district during said period of service. Council Districts 1, 2, 3, 4, and 5 shall be and correspond to those five numbered districts described in and attached to and made a part of this Act and further identified as Plan Name: lula2 Plan Type: Local User: Gina Administrator: Lula-city.

(2) When used in such attachment, the term 'Tract' and 'BG' (Block Group) shall mean and describe the same geographical boundaries as provided in the report of the Bureau of the Census for the United States decennial census of 2000 for the State of Georgia. The separate numeric designations in a Tract description which are underneath a 'BG' heading

shall mean and describe individual Blocks within a Block Group as provided in the report of the Bureau of the Census for the United States decennial census of 2000 for the State of Georgia. Any part of the City of Lula which is not included in any such district described in that attachment shall be included within that district contiguous to such part which contains the least population according to the United States decennial census of 2000 for the State of Georgia. Any part of the City of Lula which is described in that attachment as being in a particular district shall nevertheless not be included within such district if such part is not contiguous to such district. Such noncontiguous part shall instead be included within that district contiguous to such part which contains the least population according to the United States decennial census of 2000 for the State of Georgia. Except as otherwise provided in the description of any council district, whenever the description of such district refers to a named city, it shall mean the geographical boundaries of that city as shown on the census map for the United States decennial census of 2000 for the State of Georgia.

(e) The members of the city council shall be elected as provided in this subsection. On the Tuesday next following the first Monday in November, 2003, and on that date quadrennially thereafter, there shall be elected three councilmembers representing Districts 1, 4, and 5. On the Tuesday next following the first Monday in November, 2005, and on that date quadrennially thereafter, there shall be elected a mayor and two councilmembers representing Districts 2 and 3."

#### **SECTION 2.**

It is the purpose of this Act to provide for residency districts from which members of the city council of the City of Lula are to be elected in the November, 2003, general election and in subsequent general elections, and this Act results from changes in population based on the United States decennial census of 2000. It is not the intention of the General Assembly to affect the membership of current members of the council, their terms of office, or the manner in which their successors shall be elected, and such matters shall remain as provided by law on the effective date of this Act until otherwise amended by law. Those members of the city council of Lula who are serving as such on July 1, 2003, and any person elected to fill such vacancy in any such office shall continue to serve as such members until the regular expiration of their respective terms of office and upon the election and qualification of their respective successors.

#### **SECTION 3.**

The governing authority of the City of Lula shall through its legal counsel cause this Act to be submitted for preclearance under the federal Voting Rights of 1965, as amended; and such submission shall be made to the United States Department of Justice or filed with the appropriate court no later than 45 days after the date on which this Act is approved by the Governor or otherwise becomes law without such approval.

#### **SECTION 4.**

The provisions of this Act relating to and necessary for the regular election in 2003 of members of the city council of the City of Lula shall become effective upon its approval by

the Governor or upon its becoming effective without such approval; and this Act shall otherwise become effective July 1, 2003.

**SECTION 5.**

All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
