Dear Ms. Dortch:

On November 5, 2007, on behalf of the National Association of Broadcasters ("NAB"), I spoke on the telephone with Rick Chessen, Senior Legal Advisor to Commissioner Copps. I discussed NAB's Petition to Defer and its related Reply to Joint Opposition. Specifically, I discussed that NAB had proposed that the Commission defer action on the above-captioned consolidated transfer applications of XM Satellite Radio Holdings Inc. ("XM") and Sirius Satellite Radio Inc. ("Sirius") until such time as the Commission acts on applications for review of the Enforcement Bureau's grant of an NAB Freedom of Information Act request relating to various violations by XM and Sirius. I expressed NAB's view that, as a matter of procedural fairness, the Commission should, in the record of this proceeding, evaluate that information and the degree to which it sheds light on the reliability of promises made by XM and Sirius in connection with their merger application.
