
On November 5, 2007, Matthew L. Leibowitz and I, as counsel for CaribeVisión Holdings LLC., along with Harold Feld and Parul Desai of Media Access Project, met via teleconference with Michelle Carey, Senior Legal Advisor for Media Issues, and Monica Desai, Bureau Chief of the Media Bureau regarding the leased access issues raised in the above captioned proceeding.

During the telephone call, Mr. Leibowitz reviewed the concerns of leased access programmers when seeking a leased access channel, rule changes regarding leased access contracts and rates as reflected in the Comments and Reply Comments submitted on behalf of CaribeVisión Holdings, LLC.
