
RE: Re-Examination of Roaming Obligations of Commercial Mobile Radio

On November 5, 2007, Grant Spellmeyer, Director, Regulatory Affairs, United States Cellular Corporation ("USCC") and Peter Connolly of Holland & Knight LLP met with John Branscome of Commissioner Copps' office. In the meeting, the USCC representatives supported extension of the "automatic roaming" obligation to markets in which the "requesting" carrier has an FCC authorization to provide service and an expansion of the data roaming obligation to include "non-interconnected services and features," consistent with the positions taken by USCC in its pleadings in this docket.
