Re: Leased Access Channel Change

ATTENTION !

Comcast Cable Division has mandated that all Comcast Cable Systems in the country begin to migrate their FCC Leased Access Channel to Digital Cable in the next few months.

Effective **November 7, 2007** all programming currently airing in the City of Philadelphia A-1,3,4 on Channel 66 is scheduled to move to **Digital Cable Channel 190**.

As a result of this move your programming will initially be seen in fewer cable homes, as Digital Cable service will be required to receive Channel 190. However, your airtime rate will be re-calculated per the FCC Implicit Leased Access Rate Formula resulting in lower cost for your program schedule.

Those customers currently under contract for 2007 will have their rate adjusted for all programming airing after the November 7 transition date to the new *Digital Rate*.

Customers who have not yet renewed their contract for 2007 will be required to do so by November 30, 2007.

Indicated below are any actions you must take to continue your programming schedule without interruption.
