On November 5, 2007, representatives from Google Inc. ("Google"), including Eric Schmidt, Chairman and Chief Executive Officer; Sergey Brin, President of Technology; Alan Davidson, Senior Policy Counsel; Johanna Shelton, Policy Counsel and Legislative Strategist; and the undersigned attorney, met with FCC Commissioner Jonathan S. Adelstein, Renee R. Crittendon, Legal Advisor for Spectrum and International Issues, and Scott Bergmann, Legal Advisor for Wireline Issues. The Google representatives discussed the day's announcement of successful development of the Android open platform for mobile devices, and the concomitant launch of the Open Handset Alliance. During the course of the meeting, Mr. Schmidt reiterated the likelihood that Google will bid on one or more spectrum blocks in the FCC's upcoming 700 MHz auction. Messrs. Schmidt and Brin also expressed support for timely Commission approval of unlicensed uses of the TV white spaces for fixed and portable devices, and discussed recent reports concerning Internet traffic management practices by certain broadband providers.
