On November 6, 2007, I spoke on the telephone with Angela Giancarlo, Legal Advisor to Commissioner Robert McDowell, regarding the aforementioned proceeding. During that conversation, I discussed the public interest benefits of the proposed license transfers as described in the application filed in the above-referenced proceeding and as further discussed in Applicants' joint opposition. I stressed the importance of expedited action to ensure that the benefits of the transaction can accrue promptly to Dobson subscribers in its largely rural territory. I also requested prompt action on the application so AT&T can position itself to fully meet the demands of the Holiday retail season.
