Pursuant to 47 C.F.R. Section 1.1206, this notice is to inform you that on November 7, 2007, Mark Mays, Chief Executive Officer of Clear Channel Communications, Inc. ("Clear Channel"); Randall Mays, President and Chief Financial Officer of Clear Channel; Andrew Levin, Chief Legal Officer of Clear Channel; and Jessica Marventano, Senior Vice President, Government Affairs of Clear Channel met with Amy Blankenship, Commissioner Deborah Taylor Tate's Legal Advisor. During this meeting, the discussion included the positions previously raised in Clear Channel's filings in this proceeding, emphasizing how the adverse impacts of approval of the proposed XM-Sirius merger on free, over-the-air radio would be exacerbated were the Commission to fail to reform the local radio ownership limits to permit more growth in larger markets.
