**SUPPLEMENT TO PETITION FOR PARTIAL RECONSIDERATION OF
MEDIA GENERAL COMMUNICATIONS HOLDINGS, LLC**

Media General Communications Holdings, LLC (“Media General”), permittee of WRBL-DT (Columbus, Georgia) (the “Station”), by its attorneys, hereby respectfully supplements its Petition for Partial Reconsideration in the above-captioned proceeding regarding the Post-Transition DTV Table of Allotments.¹ Media General explained in the Petition that it was unable to complete its analysis because the Commission’s engineering database had been inaccessible prior to filing.² Media General therein expressed its intention to file this instant Supplement.³

Specifically, Media General hereby confirms that the revisions requested in the Petition would not create new interference in excess of the 0.1% standard the Commission has applied in creating the Post-Transition DTV Table of Allotments nor expand the allotted service area

beyond the Station's Grade B contour. The Commission has modified the allotments of stations that satisfied these conditions.⁴

Because the requested action would allow for meaningful replication while minimizing service losses and avoiding impermissible interference, Media General believes that revision of the Station's allotment and channel election certification would be in the public interest.⁵
