**MOTION FOR LEAVE TO FILE SUPPLEMENT
TO PETITION FOR PARTIAL RECONSIDERATION OF
MEDIA GENERAL COMMUNICATIONS HOLDINGS, LLC**

Media General Communications Holdings, LLC (“Media General”), permittee of WVTM-DT (Birmingham, Alabama), by its attorneys, hereby submits this Motion for Leave to File Supplement to Petition for Partial Reconsideration (“Motion”). Media General is submitting the Supplement to Petition for Partial Reconsideration (“Supplement”) concurrently with this Motion.

Consideration of the Supplement would serve the public interest because it would permit the Commission to address on the basis of a complete and full record the allotment revision requested in the timely filed Petition for Partial Reconsideration (“Petition”).¹ Media General explained in its Petition that it could not complete its analysis because the Commission’s engineering database was inaccessible for portions of the week when it was required to file the Petition.²
