**MOTION FOR LEAVE TO FILE SUPPLEMENT
TO PETITION FOR PARTIAL RECONSIDERATION OF
ARKANSAS EDUCATIONAL TELEVISION COMMISSION**

Arkansas Educational Television Commission (“AETC”), licensee of noncommercial educational stations KETS-DT (Little Rock, Arkansas), KETZ-DT (El Dorado, Arkansas), and KEMV-DT (Mountain View, Arkansas), by its attorneys, hereby submits this Motion for Leave to File Supplement to Petition for Partial Reconsideration (“Motion”). AETC is submitting the Supplement to Petition for Partial Reconsideration (“Supplement”) concurrently with this Motion.¹

Consideration of the Supplement would serve the public interest because it would permit the Commission to address on the basis of a complete and full record the allotment revision requested in the timely filed Petition for Partial Reconsideration (“Petition”).² In reference to the Commission’s 0.1% interference standard, the October 26, 2007 Petition noted, “Due to the press of activities and the schedule of AETC's consulting engineer, AETC is unable today to provide a

technical exhibit on this issue. However, AETC will supplement this petition as quickly as possible to confirm power levels, or if necessary, adjust power levels to comply with all interference considerations.”³ After reviewing the technical information with its consulting engineer, AETC confirmed that the parameters requested in the October 26, 2007 Petition will not cause KETS-DT, KETZ-DT, or KEMV-DT to exceed the 0.1% interference threshold. AETC also found that an increased HAAT for KETZ-DT will allow it to serve its coverage area while remaining within the Commission’s interference standard.

For these reasons, AETC requests that the Commission accept and consider its Supplement.
