Chris,

During our meeting last week on Rural Cellular Association's behalf we asked if the Commission would still consider it necessary to place a cap on high cost USF support to smaller CETCs if the largest four CETCs that receive support (Verizon Wireless, AT&T, T-Mobile and Alltel) agree to caps on the support they receive at the June 2007 level in connection with their pending or recently approved transactions. You requested that we compile figures showing how much the four large carriers would receive in that situation, according to USAC projections.

We have completed the research and prepared the attached list. It shows that the four above-named wireless carriers would receive \$161,618,345 in support based upon USAC 2007 Quarter 2 projections, which is 50.33% of the total projected support payable to CETCs for that quarter (\$321,145,209).
