**Request for Extension of Time from
Nickolaus E. Leggett**

I am one of the original petitioners for the establishment of the Low Power FM (LPFM) radio broadcasting service (RM-9208 July 7, 1997 subsequently included in MM Docket 99-25). I am also a certified electronics technician (ISCET and NARTE) and an Extra Class amateur radio operator (call sign N3NL). I am an inventor holding three U.S. Patents. My latest patent is a wireless bus for digital devices and computers (U.S. Patent # 6,771,935). I have a Master of Arts degree in Political Science from the Johns Hopkins University. I am also one of the petitioners in the recent docket to establish a low power radio service on the AM broadcast band (RM-11287).

Unusual Document

I was rather surprised to encounter the individual regulatory proposal from Chairman Kevin J. Martin. In my over 30 years of interacting with the Commission, I have become used to the Commission asking for comments as

a combined body. So I am somewhat at a loss on how to deal with an individual proposal.

Request for More Time

The comment deadline of December 11, 2007 is too soon for this major issue. Many possible commentators will be away for the Thanksgiving holidays and so they will have less than a month to study the Chairman's proposals and develop comments on his proposals. For example, I will be away for two weeks at a family reunion.

In my opinion the issue of media ownership is of basic importance for American democracy. I think that American democracy deserves more than a 30-day comment period. The comment period should be extended to 90 days. This will allow all parties to examine Chairman Martin's proposals in detail and respond with their own comprehensive comments.
