
Re: Notification of *Ex Parte* Communications

On Tuesday, November 13, David Donovan, President of the Association for Maximum Service Television, Inc. and its undersigned counsel, spoke with Catherine Bohigian, Chief of the Office of Strategic Planning and Policy Analysis, at the FCC about the unlicensed devices proceeding (ET Docket No. 04-186). Specifically, we discussed OET's field testing plans, concerns about the lack of geographical diversity in the sites where apparently the tests will take place, the possibility of broadcast industry support for further testing after this next initial round of testing and alternative uses for the so-called white spaces.
