Today, Curt Stamp, Executive Director of the Independent Telephone & Telecommunications Alliance (ITTA), and the undersigned met with John Hunter of Commissioner Robert McDowell's office. We discussed proposals for short-term and long-term modifications to the Universal Service Fund, consistent with comments filed previously by ITTA in the above-referenced dockets, and emphasized the importance of an interim cap on support for CETCs while long-term solutions are developed.

We also discussed briefly the *DTV Consumer Education Initiative* proceeding, and jurisdictional and commercial speech issues contemplated by a proposal to require providers of Lifeline/Link-Up services to issue bill inserts regarding DTV transition.
