On November 14, 2007, Matthew L. Leibowitz, as counsel to CaribeVisión Holdings, LLC and Carlos Barba, Chairman of CaribeVisión Holdings, LLC, along with Harold Feld and Parul Desai of Media Access Project, Peter Tannenwald of Campbell & Tannenwald, Counsel for Community Broadcaster's Association, Ron Bruno, President of Bruno/Grandworth Network, met with Rudy Brioche, Legal Advisor for Media Issues to Commissioner Adelstein, Rich Chessen, Senior Legal Advisor/Media Advisor to Commissioner Copps, Michelle Carey, Senior Legal Advisor/Media Issues to Chairman Martin, Amy Blankenship, Legal Advisor to Commissioner Tate & Christina Pauze, Legal Advisor/Media Issues to Commissioner McDowell.

During the meetings, Mr. Leibowitz discussed the concerns of leased access programmers when seeking a leased access channel and the associated rates charged by cable operators as more fully set forth in the Comments & Reply Comments submitted on behalf of CaribeVisión Holdings, LLC. Additionally, the parties discussed the range of rate variation when analyzed on a per subscriber basis as well as the fact that 35% of CaribeVisión's budget goes directly to leased access fees.
