Dear Ms. Dortch:

On behalf of MMM License II LLC (FRN: 0011094281) ("Max Media"), the licensee of the above-referenced station, we hereby request a temporary extension of waiver of the July 1, 2006 "use-it-or-lose-it" interference protection deadline (the "Deadline"). The extension is warranted because Max Media cannot officially complete construction of the KFBB-DT facility until the Commission grants the pending license application.

KFBB-TV is authorized to operate on NTSC Channel 5 and KFBB-DT is authorized to operate on Channel 8. KFBB-DT elected to maximize on its DTV Channel post transition. Currently, KFBB-DT is fully licensed at less-than-replication facilities of 3.39 kW with an antenna at 146 meters HAAT (see File No. BLCDDT-20020507AAI).

On July 7, 2006, Max Media filed a modification application for KFBB-DT specifying full replication facilities.<sup>1</sup> A request for waiver of the Deadline for KFBB-DT (the "Waiver") was also filed on July 7, 2006 seeking interference protection of KFBB-DT's replication coverage until the modification application was granted and construction was completed. The Commission granted the Waiver on May 18, 2007, providing an additional six months to "fully build and operate" the KFBB-DT facility.


