Dear Ms. Dortch:

Reno License, LLC (“Reno License”), by and through its attorneys, hereby requests an Extension of the Waiver of the “Use or Lose” Deadline granted on May 17, 2007.¹ Reno License is the licensee of Station KREN-TV and the permittee of Station KREN-DT, Reno, Nevada (the “Station”). The *Order* took note of the efforts of Reno License in constructing KREN-DT, and granted the initial request for waiver of the July 1, 2006 Replication/Maximization Interference Deadline (the “Deadline”) established in the DTV Second Periodic Review.²

Reno License has been unable to construct the authorized digital television (DTV) facilities for the Station due to severe financial constraints and unfavorable weather conditions at the Station’s transmitter site. Pursuant to Section 0.459 of the Commission’s rules, Reno License is separately submitting under confidential cover the supporting information for the Request for Extension of the Waiver. Confidential treatment is appropriate since the financial
