**Re: Request for Extension of Waiver of the "Use or Lose" Deadline
MB Docket No. 03-15
WSTR-DT, Cincinnati, Ohio (FIN #11204)**

Dear Ms. Dortch:

On behalf of WSTR Licensee, Inc., permittee of digital television station WSTR-DT, Cincinnati, Ohio, this letter is to request an extension of its six-month waiver of the July 1, 2006 replication/maximization interference protection deadline (the "use or lose deadline") granted to the licensee in the Commission's *Use or Lose Order*.^{1/}

WSTR-DT is authorized operate with an effective radiated power ("ERP") of 675 kW at an antenna radiation center height above average terrain of 337 meters. See FCC File No. BMPCDT-20060630AAG. For technical reasons involving other broadcast facilities located on the proposed antenna support structure (ASR1014132), WSTR-DT has filed an application for modification of the station's construction permit proposing to lower the antenna to a height of 250 meters above ground level on the tower (522.8 meters AMSL). See FCC File No. BMPCDT-20070720AAM. In order to compensate for the reduced height, the application also proposed to increase the station's ERP from

the currently authorized 675 kW to 900 kW. Once that application is granted, the licensee will expeditiously file a license application for those facilities.

For these reasons, the permittee respectfully requests that the Commission grant it a waiver of the "use or lose" deadline so as to permit the grant of its pending application for modification of the WSTR-DT construction permit and the filing of a covering license application.
