**Hearing Aid Compatibility Report**

Kaplan Telephone Company, Inc. d/b/a Pace Communications (“Pace”), by its attorneys, pursuant to the Federal Communications Commission’s (“Commission” or “FCC”) *Order* in WT Docket No. 01-309,<sup>1</sup> and the subsequent *Public Notice* in the same proceeding,<sup>2</sup> hereby files its Seventh Report detailing its compliance efforts with the FCC’s hearing aid compatibility requirements. Pace is including in its Seventh Report all information of which it has knowledge, but does not address those reporting requirements in the *Order* that can only be adequately answered by individual handset manufacturers.

**I. Carrier Background**

Pace is a small Commercial Mobile Radio Service (“CMRS”) carrier that provides service in rural Louisiana.

**II. Handsets Currently Offered for Sale**

All of the 5 handsets Pace currently offers for sale have been certified by the FCC’s Office of Engineering and Technology as T-rated and/or M-rated hearing aid compatible (HAC):
